Purposes of Collection and Use	Processing of applications and verification of applicant identity for the open search process; verification of applicant eligibility, professional licenses and certifications, professional experience, and coaching achievements; administration of application screening and interview evaluations; notification of selection results; selection and appointment decisions; preparation of engagement agreements; and handling of objections and selection-related disputes.
Categories of Personal Information Collected	Full name, date of birth, nationality, mobile phone number, email address, position applied for, name of the applicant for Head Coach of the prospective team, headshot photograph (if submitted), educational background, coaching and performance analysis experience, professional licenses and qualifications, major tournament records and coaching achievements, awards and honors, academic/research/lecturing activities, and any other selection-related information included in the submitted application materials.
Retention and Use Period	Unsuccessful Applicants: Retained for 180 days from the official announcement date of the final appointee(s) and securely destroyed without delay thereafter. Appointees: Information required for the execution and administration of the engagement agreement is retained for five (5) years following the termination thereof and securely destroyed thereafter.
Right to Withhold Consent and Consequences of Refusal	You have the right to withhold your consent to the collection and use of your personal information. However, the information specified above is required for application processing and the administration of the selection process; as such, failure to grant consent will preclude you from applying for or proceeding with the open search process.

■ CONSENT TO PROCESSING OF SENSITIVE INFORMATION

The Korea Football Association does not require applicants to submit criminal and investigative records issued for personal verification, nor does it directly inquire into applicants' criminal records with law enforcement agencies, unless otherwise provided by applicable law. Verification of grounds for disqualification is conducted based on the applicant's executed Declaration of Eligibility and Absence of Grounds for Disqualification and supporting documentation to the extent permitted by law.

Purposes of Processing	Verification of grounds for disqualification under Article 10 of the Korean Sport & Olympic Committee's Regulations on National Team Selection and Management; evaluation of applicant eligibility; selection and appointment decisions; and implementation of follow-up measures in the event of false declarations or post-appointment discovery of disqualification grounds.
Categories of Information Processed	Information regarding whether any grounds for disqualification under the aforementioned Regulations apply—including criminal convictions, sexual offenses (sexual violence, sexual harassment, and prostitution), driving under the influence, gambling, stalking, school violence, human rights violations, and disciplinary records from any affiliated sports organization—and any related materials voluntarily submitted by the applicant during the explanation process.
Retention and Use Period	Unsuccessful Applicants: Retained for 180 days from the official announcement date of the final appointees and securely destroyed without delay thereafter. Appointees: Information required for the execution and administration of the engagement agreement is retained for five (5) years following the termination thereof and securely destroyed thereafter.
Right to Withhold Consent and Consequences of Refusal	You have the right to withhold your consent to the processing of your sensitive information. However, verification of grounds for disqualification is a prerequisite for the appointment of the interim head coach and coaching staff of the national team; accordingly, failure to grant consent will preclude you from applying for or proceeding with the open search process.

■ NOTICE ON PERSONAL INFORMATION PROCESSING
